## Boosts Red Cross

"The Red Cross saved my life. I want you to do all you can to help it. I want you to take \$10 out of my fund and donate it to the Red Cross." This is the message sent by Sergeant Daniel Ritter from a German prison camp to his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Ritter, Nazareth R. I. But his dad, an employe of Brown-Borhek, in this city, says: "Take the money from his fund? He's giving enough. But you can be sure his parents will help the Red Cross!" Sergeant Ritter is believed to have been in a prison camp liberated by the Russian drive.
