LAUDS ENGLISH HOSTS

"It's been 13 months since I've seen the States, but the way we're being treated here, I don't feel homesick at all," commented Corporal Francis Kelleher, 23 years old, of 907 East Fourth Street, Bethlehem.

"We've really been shown hospitality over here and made to feel right at home by the English people," he said. "Of course, I'd sort of like to see what home looks like, but I don't feel at all lonesome or homesick the way I thought I would."

Corporal Kelleher is in the Signal Corps of the United States Army and is in a signal intelligence section, stationed somewhere in England. He has been in the Army 18 months. Before entering the service he was employed in a steel mill.
