### Missing, Safe?



Mrs. Paul Sames, the former Florence Shelly, 128 Park Avenue, Quakertown, received a telegram reporting her husband missing in action December 20 in Luxembourg. Mrs. Sames has since received word from Lieut. Harry B. Sames, a brother also stationed in Luxembourg with the 17th Airborne Division, stating he had received a letter from the missing brother, dated January 6, and mailed from a rest camp in Luxembourg. Sergeant Sames entered the Army, February 17, 1944, while employed in the Sales Department of the Bethlehem Steel Company. He received his training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and was sent overseas to England in August, 1944. He has seen action in France, Belgium, Germany and throughout the Luxembourg area.
