**Otto F. Mulzet APR 10 1945
Promoted In France**

A NINTH AIR FORCE BOMBER BASE, France—The promotion of Oto F. Mulzet, 22, of 1626 West North Street, Bethlehem, to sergeant has been announced at a U. S. Ninth Air Force A-26 Invader medium bomber base in France.

Sergeant Mulzet is a gunner in the "Famous 416th" Bomb Group

which has been attacking tactical targets along the western front. Recent attacks on railroad yards and ordnance depots have helped disrupt the enemy's flow of supplies and set the stage for the advance of our troops to the Rhine. The Invader in which Sergeant Mulzet flies is the Army's newest, most versatile and most destructive bomber. It was introduced into combat by the "Famous 416th."

Entering the service on August 9, 1943, Sergeant Mulzet arrived overseas on November 21, 1944. He was a machinist apprentice at the Bethlehem Steel Company before he entered the Army.

April 10, 1945
