**Soldier Sends
Nazi Flag to
Donchez Family** JUN 4 1945

Among a number of souvenirs sent to Mrs. Anna Donchez, 404 East Fourth Street, by Technical Sergeant Robert D. Wickes, is a large Nazi flag, believed to have been used at one of the enemy's headquarters. A letter referring to the flag stated that it was captured "somewhere south of Berlin."

Sergeant Wickes has been in service for about three and one-half years, and served in major campaigns with the Third Army. A former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, he made his home with Mrs. Donchez and family. He is a native of New Rochelle, N. Y.
