Pfc. William Heacock, son of Mr. and Mrs. Earl Heacock of 217 East Union Boulevard, returned recently on brief furlough from overseas service with a field artillery observation battalion of the Fifth Army.

Recently promoted to his present rank, the young soldier left for overseas duty last March. Since that time, he has journeyed through all the large cities of Italy and has been awarded the Good Conduct Medal and the European Theater of Operations ribbon with one battle star. He is a 1944 graduate of Liberty High School who trained at Fort Sill, Okla., and at Fort Bragg, N. C.

While overseas, Pfc. Heacock met two Bethlehem pals; Warren Achey, T/5C, of 830 Main Street; and Corp. Donald Reiss of 1520 Easton Avenue.
