Prisoner Of Japs 9 Word has been received here from Pfc. Michael Barron, 25, a prisoner of the Japanese in Tokio for more than two years, telling relatives he is well and anxious for mail. It was the first communication in the sol-dier's handwriting since he was cap-tured with the fall of Bataan. The letter, on Japanese form sta-tionery, was written to his brother, Andrew, 31 Ackerman Street, Hel-lertown, and received by the lat-ter's wife. The writer is unaware his brother is now in the Army and stationed in England," bringing to four the number of brothers in ser-vice.

vice. Pvt, Charles Barron, 27, is also a prisoner of the Japanese and when last heard from was confined in conquered Ghinese territory. Pvt, Steven Barron is stationed some-

where in the Philippines. The brothers lived at 445 Butler Street, this city, before entering the service.
