Wounded In Action**

Mrs. Ray C. Ziegenfuss, of 1313 Iron Street, this city, received a telegram from the War Department informing her that her son, Pvt. Russell C. Ziegenfuss, 18, U. S. Army Infantry, was slightly wounded in action.

Private Ziegenfuss, who entered the service June 15, 1944, was wounded January 21 in the Luxembourg area. He went overseas in December of last year, after training at Camp Wheeler, Ga.

Prior to entering the service, he was employed by the Laros Silk Company.
