Pfc. James W. Knowles, son of Mr. and Mrs. J. C. Knowles of 409 Center Street, has completed four weeks of jump training and now wears the Wings and Boots of the United States Army Paratroops. During the four weeks, he made five jumps from a plane in flight, the last a tactical jump at night involving a combat problem on landing.
