Machinist Mate 2nd Class William J. Miller, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Miller, 650 Leibert Street, has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal and the vice as set forth in a secret Presidential Citation "for sercipation distinguished by gallantry and intrepidity in action in the assault and occupation of an enemy held island, and despite determined enemy activity, carried out his duties in a calm and efficient manner."

Machinist Mate Miller enlisted in the Seabees September 17, 1943, and received his boot training at Camp Perry, Va. Since then, he has taken part in the major Pacific campaigns including the battles for Saipan, Marianas and the Marshalls.

October 20, 1944
