Designed to acquaint newly appointed officers with every possible element in Navy life, the school, under the command of Capt. W. E. Cheadle, USN (Ret.) specializes in visual training, teaching the student officers naval subjects by actual practice, in addition to studying primary text books.

The course is supplemented with a rigorous physical education program designed to give the young officers rugged bodies, fitting them for strenuous duties either ashore or afloat.
