Pvt. Jos. Lazar Dies In Action In Germany

Pvt. Joseph Lazar, 26, husband of the former Miss Tweilla Trexler, Bethlehem R. D. 3, was killed in action on April 28 while participating in an engagement in Germany. His wife received an official notification on Saturday.

Born in Bethlehem, he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph L. Lazar. He attended Bethlehem Technical High School and was formerly employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.

He was inducted into the combat forces on March 27, 1944, and following training in an anti-aircraft unit at Camp Stewart, Ga., and Camp Hahn, Cal., he was transferred to an infantry unit and sent to Camp Howze, Texas. He went overseas in January of this year.

Besides his wife and a son, Joseph J., he is survived by his parents, a brother, Pfc. Edward Lazar, assigned to an airbourne unit, and a sister, Mrs. Mary Halter, New York City.
