"Injured in action in Belgium, January 20," were the words of the War Department wire received this morning by Attorney and Mrs. Victor J. Abel of 338 Main Street, Hellertown, describing the condition of their son, Corporal Victor J. Abel Jr. No other details are available at this time. Corporal Abel was inducted in April of 1943 while he was a law prep student at Ursinus College. He graduated with the 1942 class at Hellertown High, receiving his Army training at Camp Mackall, N. C., and at Camp Forrest, Tenn. In October of 1944 he was shipped overseas with the 17th Air Borne Division of the Army.
