Wilt, of 829 Spring Street, city, has entered the Army Air Forces Training Command School at Yale University for Aviation Cadet training in Aircraft Maintenance Engineering.

This is the proving ground for cadets who will soon be in charge of a crew of enlisted men specialists, supervising the maintenance and operation of American aircraft.

Upon successful completion of his course he will be commissioned a second lieutenant and assigned to active duty with a Yank combat squadron.
