**Several From Here  
In New WAVE Class**

PHILADELPHIA—Eighty women from Eastern Pennsylvania, Delaware and southern New Jersey will leave here Thursday for Hunter College, New York City, to begin five weeks' indoctrination as enlisted WAVES.

The group, which will travel to the New York training school by bus, will include 26 from Philadelphia itself, seven from New Jersey and two from Delaware. On completion of the indoctrination course they either will be ordered to active duty immediately or sent to other Navy schools for specialist training.
