After treating more than eight thousand wounded American soldiers during a year of operation, the 104th General Hospital has completed its mission in England.

Among those serving with this hospital were: First Lt. Betty L. Musselman, general duty nurse, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Warren C. Musselman, 341 Liberty Street, and Pfc. Warren D. Mumbauer, ambulance driver, 249 East Garrison Street.

The hospital unit was activated in New Orleans in July, 1943, and received training at Camp Pickett, Va. The last patient taken care of by Lt. Musselman and Pfc. Mumbauer was in July. **AUG 23 1945**
