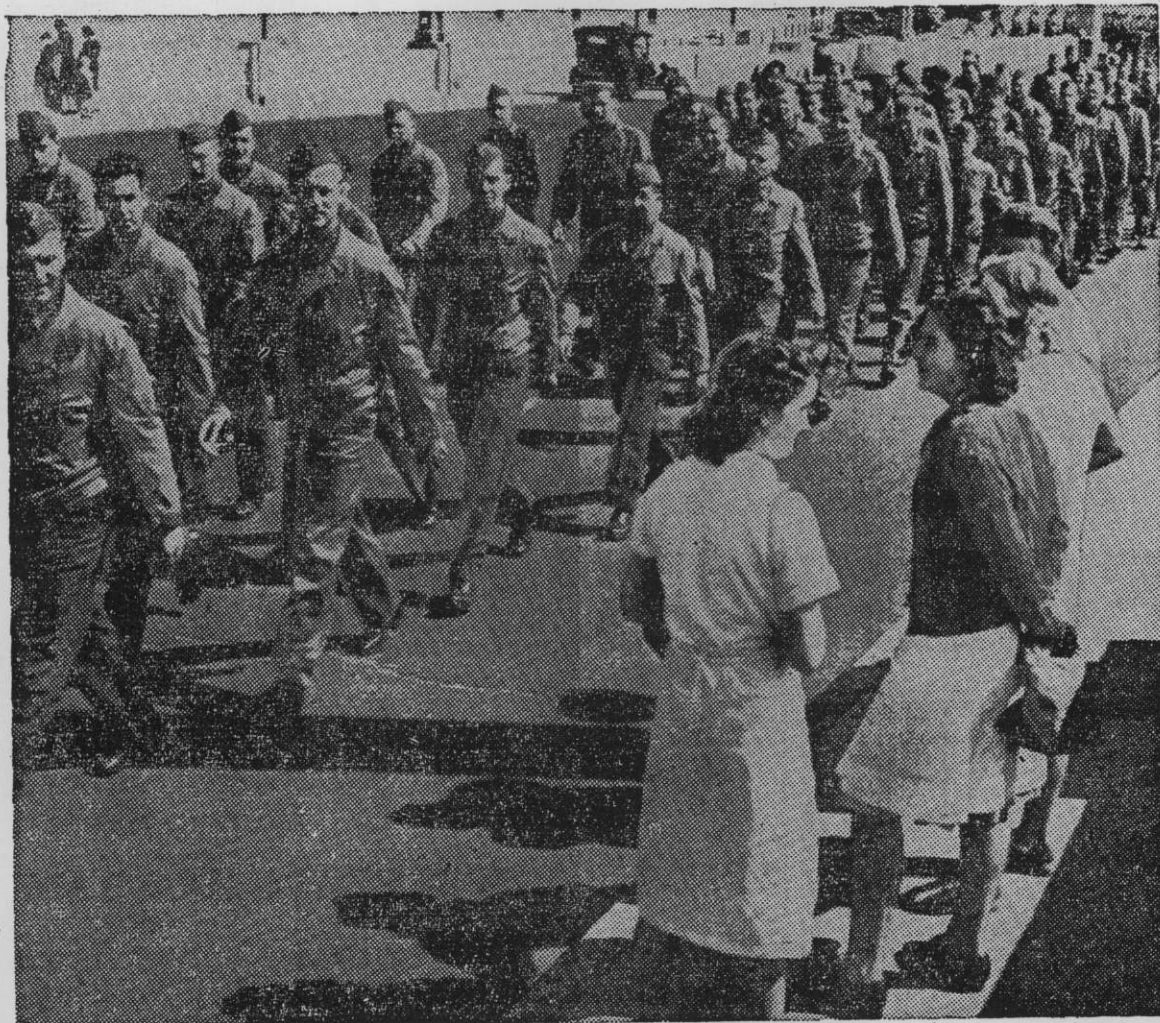


Bauman, Bruce



BETHLEHEM MARINE MARCHING IN AUSTRALIA—Parents of two U. S. Marines, one from this city and the other from Allentown, as well as relatives and friends of the young men will rejoice when they see in a photograph of Marines landing in Australia Bruce, son of Mr. and Mrs. Nevin Bauman and nephew of Councilman Henry K. Bauman, and Robert, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Gallagher. The Baumans reside at 926 South Eighth Street, Allentown, and the Gallaghers on Fifth Avenue, this city. Both Bauman and Gallagher are shown in the Associated Press Marine Corps photograph above, both being in the first file. Bauman is the third in line from the left, with Gallagher following him. The young men enlisted immediately after Pearl Harbor. They had never met before but soon struck up a close friendship, which was transmitted to their respective parents who have become close friends. Mr. Gallagher, Sr., is a former police chief of Kutztown and is now a sergeant of police at the Bethlehem Steel plant.
