
Jones, Arthurts

Mr. and Mrs. A. Stanley Jones, 830 North New Street, have received a telegram from the Navy Department telling them of the serious illness of their son, Arthur H. Jones, seaman second class. He is confined in St. Albans Naval Hospital, L. I., N. Y., with spinal meningitis, having been admitted last Saturday.

About four weeks ago, when returning to his station after swimming in Brooklyn, he was attacked

while walking on 58th Street, was struck over the head and robbed of money and trinkets. He was found money and trinkets. He was found unconscious by the shore patrol and was taken to a hospital. After several days' treatment, he was sent back to his station, but has not felt well since the atack. He was on furlough two weeks ago and complained then of not feeling well. Jones received his boot training at Sampson, N. Y., and from there was transferred to New York. He attended Liberty High School and was in the employ of Brown-Borhek before entering the Navy.
