

Strawn, Harold

Reported Dead

Reported missing in action during combat over Berlin a year and a half ago, Sgt. Harold Strawn has been officially declared killed in action in a letter from Major General Ulio received by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ambrose Strawn, this morning. The letter stated that Sgt. Strawn was buried "somewhere in France."

A radio-gunner on a B-17, Sgt. Harold Strawn was sent overseas in March, 1943, and was reported missing over Berlin, December 30, 1943. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps November 23, 1941, and was assigned to Jefferson Barracks, near St. Louis, Mo., where he passed the entrance examinations for Chanutte Field, Rantoul, Ill. He graduated from the aeronautical technical school there May 7, 1942.
