**Lieut. Lindstrum  
Suffers Shrapnel  
Wound, Fracture**

Yesterday Mrs. George L. Grossman, 709 Fifth Avenue, received a wire with definite news of the condition of her son, First Lieutenant Gustav G. Lindstrum, reported August 1 to have been wounded in France July 14. At that time no details were available, but it is now known that the young man is hospitalized overseas for a shrapnel wound in the arm and a fractured skull.

Lt. Lindstrum, a graduate of Lehigh University, class of '38 in the department of electrical engineering, was inducted May 14, 1942. In December, 1943, he shipped overseas. He was stationed in England prior to the invasion serving with the infantry.

August 12, 1944
