members of the family and intimate friends. He is shown in the picture "Sahara," being a member of a military unit that portrayed the part of Nazi soldiers.

He enlisted in the Army on May 28, 1942, and was assigned to the Fourth Armored Division, receiving his preliminary training at Fort Knox, Ky. He was later transferred

to California, where the division was pressed into service in the making of the motion picture. At present he is stationed in Texas. Before joining the combat forces he was an employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
