**Pfc. Albert Radgowski
Serves As Cavalry Scout**

WITH THE 38TH INFANTRY
DIVISION ON BATAAN—Pfc. Al-
bert C. Radgowski served as a scout
lead of the 38th Cavalry Recon-
naissance Troop in the drive
launched by the 38th Infantry Divi-
sion to avenge Bataan.

On one occasion Pvt. Radgowski
and his platoon reconnoitered an
enemy headquarters located in Bo-
tolan chromite and copper mines at
the northern Zambales province,
wiping out the Japs, and occupying
the mines which were then in opera-
tion.

He has been overseas for more
than a year serving in Hawaii and
New Guinea before coming to the
Philippines. He is entitled to wear
the Good Conduct Medal, Asiatic-
Pacific and Philippines Liberation
ribbons.

He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John
Radgowski who reside at 1403 East
Fifth Street, Bethlehem, Pa. He
attended Bethlehem High School
and was a football player.
