#### WOUNDED IN AFRICA

Sergeant Stanley A. Beers, son of Mr. and Mrs. William H. Beers, 1017 Berwick Street, Easton, was wounded in the battling in Tunisia, the War Department announced yesterday.

Word direct from the injured Easton soldier had beaten the War Department's announcement to his home. It developed yesterday when inquiries were made of his father and mother at the Berwick Street home.

"But Stanley hasn't yet told us what his injuries are," said the mother. "He has written that he was wounded, and nothing more."

Stanley is only one of three stalwart sons in the armed service. His brother Edwin is in the anti-aircraft service. Brother Kenneth is with the quartermaster corps at Camp Forrest in Tennessee.

The African war veteran has been in the Army for more than two years.
