In a long distance telephone call to Panama Mrs. Catherine M. Wenrich, who resides with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. William J. Pfeifle, 1340 Stanley Avenue, Fountain Hill, on Sunday learned that her husband, Private First Class Lawrence E. Wenrich, attached to the U. S. Army Medical Corps at Panama, was promoted to corporal on January 21.

The husband commented during the conversation that he is in good health and that he hopes the war may be over "in time to be home to attend the Allentown Fair next Fall." He was unable to tell about his work or at what place he is stationed.

Corporal Wenrich, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Wenrich, of Philadelphia, formerly of Perkasio, was graduated from the Perkasio High School. He was inducted into the U. S. Army service in April, 1941 and sent to Fort Lee, Va., and then to Fort Dix, Md. Fourteen months ago he was transferred to Panama. He was last home on a furlough over the 1941 Christmas season.
