The 9th Armored Division had an outstanding part in the Battle of the Bulge and was commended for its fighting by the commanders of two armies, three corps and four divisions. Later the 9th Armored was applauded by the entire Allied world for its spectacular capture of the first bridge across the Rhine, at Remagen.

Lt. Cowin is the son of Prof. R. B. Cowin, of 1124 North New Street, Bethlehem. His Army job is adjutant. He recently received the Bronze Star Medal for meritorious service, as a liaison officer.
