## Draft Board <sup>SEP 1</sup> 1943 No. 3 to Send 24 Into Services

Twenty-four men called up by Selective Service Board No. 3, 713 Eighth Avenue, Bethlehem, have been sworn into the service of the United States. Ten will go into the Navy, one into the Coast Guard, one into the U. S. Marines and 12 to the Army. Of the latter one will become an Air Cadet.
