Lt. Estaline Hamm Becomes Bride Of Army Captain

Announcement has been received in Bethlehem of the marriage of Lieut. Estaline G. Hamm, Women's Army Corps, and Capt. Lloyd H. Leslie, Army of the United States, son of Mr. and Mrs. L. H. Leslie, of Toronto, Canada. The marriage took place June 17 in the chapel of Colorado College, Colorado Springs, Colo. Dean R. Hazleton, of the college, officiated. Capt. and Mrs. Leslie are now residing at 512 South Hancock Street, Colorado Springs.

Mrs. Leslie, who made her home with Mr. and Mrs. Robert Young, of 827 Beverly Avenue, is a graduate of Liberty High School and was employed by the Allentown-Bethlehem Gas Company before entering the service. She enlisted in November, 1942, trained at Des Moines, Iowa and was commissioned May 10, 1943. She was sent to Bethlehem in June, 1943, to open a temporary recruiting office here and served as its recruiting officer for 30 days. Lieut. Leslie is now stationed at Camp Carson, Colo.

Capt. Leslie, a native of Toronto, Canada, was graduated from the University of Toronto in 1933, received his master's degree from the University of California and was graduated from Harvard University in business administration. He was a member of the faculty of Whittier College before joining the Army.
