Word was received in Bangor last evening that Pfc. Frank Tilli of the United States Army was killed in action on the Island of Luzon in the Philippines on Jauary 26. He entered the service in June, 1941; received basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and other training at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., and St. Lewis Obisbo, Calif. He went overseas in July, 1943, spending six months at Hawaii and a year in New Guinea.
