### Six Bethlehem Sailors On Aircraft Carrier

ABOARD A LIGHT AIRCRAFT CARRIER IN THE PACIFIC—Six Bethlehem, Pa., Navy men who helped put this ship into commission at Camden, N. J., have fought her through two years of Pacific war. They are: Donald Vollman, William Hess, Lewis Luther, Michael Petrosky, Donald Romig and William Chuck.

The Bethlehem men all reported to the Naval Training Center, Sampson, N. Y., in February, 1943, for recruit training.

Chuck, 21, seaman first class, belongs to an anti-aircraft gun crew that has shot down two Jap planes, a twin-engined Betty torpedo plane and a single-engined Val dive bomber. The Betty, which had missed in an earlier attack on a major unit of a task group, was downed after it had dropped its torpedo, missing the ship by a few feet.
