Dr. Rothrock Now Captain In U. S. Navy

Commander Henry Rothrock, formerly of 821 North Bishopthorpe Street, has been elevated to the rank of Captain in the Medical Corps, USNR, according to information received here from his wife, Katherine, who resides in Rising Sun, Md.

Capt. Rothrock volunteered for service in June, 1941, and was called

to active duty January 5, 1942. Prior to shipment overseas, he served in the Philadelphia and Norfolk Naval Hospitals.

Shipping overseas with a mobile hospital unit in 1942, Capt. Rothrock served as pathologist with the same unit in New Caledonia.

The young naval officer is on leave from St. Luke's Hospital, where he was pathologist for 10 years before his departure. At present Capt. Rothrock is director of laboratories and is in charge of the Allergy Clinic at the U. S. Naval Hospital in Bainbridge, Md.
