Floyd H. Stoudt, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ira Stoudt, Tatamy, was cited by Lieut. Col. Charles J. Blake Jr., of the 228th Field Artillery Battalion, in recognition of "conspicuously meritorious and outstanding performance of military duty" somewhere in Germany. "November 23, 1944, while actively engaged in military operations against enemy in Germany, T/5 Stoudt distinguished himself by laying and maintaining communication lines in heavily mined areas in the midst of considerable enemy mortar and artillery fire. By such courageous action, he reflects great credit upon himself and the military service."
