**Corp. A. Davis,
Bangor R. D. 1,
Dies in Action**

Corporal Alvin Davis, son of Mrs. Sarah Davis, of Bangor R. D. 1, has been killed in action in the North African theater of war, according to word received from the War Department. Further details were not given.

Corporal Davis entered the Army on October 19, 1940, by enlisting and was a member of a Ranger outfit of the U. S. Infantry in North Africa.

Surviving other than his mother are two brothers, who are both in the Army, Sergeant Charles E., Fort Eustis, Va., and Sergeant Houston A., Shreveport, La.; four sisters, Mrs. Howard Lohman and Lucinda Davis, of North Bangor; Mrs. Robbie Davis, of Florida, and Mrs. Cleo Richard, of Knoxville, Tenn.
