Private First Class Arland V. Kemmerer, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Kemmerer, Coopersburg, R. D. 1, formerly of Helertown, has informed his parents of his recent promotion and award of the Bronze Star for "meritorious service in Normandy."

Inducted April 3, 1943, he has been serving overseas with a Medical Battalion of the famous 28th Pennsylvania Division since October last year. He has seen action in France, Belgium, Luxembourg and was in the sector where the Nazi counter-attack took place last December.

Pfc. Kemmerer recently spent a short furlough in Paris and is now back with his division in Germany. Prior to entering the service, Kemmerer was employed in a local chain store.
