WOUNDED IN ACTION

Sgt. Paul Seyfried, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred E. Seyfried, 223 Belvidere Street, Nazareth, has been slightly wounded in action in the North African area, a telegram from the War Department April 12 informs his parents. Sgt. Seyfried was wounded March 30. Further details will follow, the message says.

The Nazareth soldier was inducted into the Army June 26, 1941 and sent overseas August 16, 1942. He was stationed at Ft. Bragg, N. C., before leaving for foreign duty. He had been a bookkeeper in the employ of Ziegler's garage, Nazareth, before going into the service.

His family had a letter from him dated March 25 just a day or so ago.
