Chester Frantz, Nazareth Soldier, Wounded on Luzon

Mr. and Mrs. Harry Frantz, North Main Street, Nazareth, were notified by the War Department that their son, Pfc. Chester C. Frantz, was wounded in action on Luzon on Feb. 13.

He is a Paratrooper with the 11th Airborne and completed two years of service on March 4. He is a patient in the 105th General Hospital.

Pfc. Frantz entered the service on March 4, 1944, and was stationed at Camp Mackall, N. C., and Camp Polk, La. He has seen service in Leyte and the Philippines.
