**STEPHEN NEMETH, JR.,
BECOMES LIEUTENANT**

**Local Man in Army Since 1931—Now
With Second Service Command.**

Announcement has been made of the promotion of Stephen Nemeth, Jr., son of Mrs. Julia Nemeth, 828 Laufer Avenue, this city, from Warrant Officer to Second Lieutenant, U. S. Army.

Lieut. Nemeth enlisted July 1, 1931, when he was assigned to an Engineers unit in the Panama Canal Zone. He served there as corporal and sergeant, returning to the United States in May, 1934.

Until 1935 he was at the Brooklyn, N. Y., Army base, then was transferred to the Reserve Officers Training Corps duty at Xavier High School, New York City, where he served as a sergeant instructor until May 14, this year, when he was appointed a warrant officer, effective May 15, and transferred to Governor's Island, N. Y.

Appointed Second Lieutenant August 17 in the Army Military Police Corps, he was ordered to the Provost Marshal School Center, Fort Oglethorpe, Ga., September 3, for a refresher course. After successfully completing this course he was graduated October 30 and ordered back to the Second Service Command with which he is now on duty.

Lieutenant Nemeth attended Liberty High School in 1926. Before enlistment he was employed as a clerk and shipper in the steel foundry of the Bethlehem Steel Company's local plant.
