## Succumbs to War Wounds

Private First Class Owen R. Reiman, U. S. M. C., died from wounds received in the service of his country, March 17, on Iwo Jima, his father, Lloyd F. Reiman, 605 Broadway, was informed in an official telegram received Tuesday.

Pfc. Reiman had been on active duty with the Fourth Marine Division for the past two years. He attended Broughal Junior High School and Bethlehem Technical High School before entering the service.

Surviving are his parents, his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Jennie Reiman, his maternal grandmother, Mrs. Sarah Williams, and the following brothers and sisters: Pfc. Lloyd Reiman, U. S. M. C., who served 26 months on Guadalcanal, now stationed in Williamsburg, Va.; Charles, Delbert, Donald and Geraldine, at home.
