Bernard L. Timmer Ends Navy Service

Having served in the U. S. Navy for two years, eight months and 23 days, Bernard L. Timmer, SM2/C, ended his naval career at Bainbridge, Md., Feb. 18, when he received his honorable discharge.

Timmer enlisted May 26, 1943, while a student at Bethlehem Technical High School. After completing his boot training at Sampson, N. Y., he received amphibious training at Little Creek, Va., and was assigned to the LST-212, on which he served most of his active duty. He is entitled to wear the American Theater ribbon and the European Theater ribbon with two battle participation stars.

The former Navy man expects to enter Lafayette College to study metallurgy. His brother, Francis Timmer, SF2/C, is serving with the Navy in Philadelphia aboard the USS Savannah.
