Suffers Wounds

Pvt. John E. Lance, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Lance, 59 West Laurel Street, was wounded in action October 25, 1944, in Italy, and has received the Purple Heart.

A former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company he was inducted October 16, 1943. He took his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and at Fort Meade, Md., before shipping overseas to the Strait of Gibraltar and on to Africa, Italy, and Pisa, where he was transferred to a rifle unit in the Infantry.

A brother, Pfc. Robert A. Lance is with the Air Corps in the Hawaiian Islands.
