

Prisoner of Nazis

Private Michael Kelemonick (above), son of Mr. and Mrs. John Kelemonick, 1705 East Fourth Street, missing since February 17 in the North African area, is held prisoner by the Germans according to the telegram which was received by his parents May 8. The telegram reads thus: "Report just received through International Red Cross states that your son, Pvt. Michael Kelemonick, is a prisoner of war of the German Government."

He is a graduate of Bethlehem High School with the class of 1941. Prior to his induction into the U. S. Army he was formerly employed in the office of Lehigh University.
