### Nazareth Gunner Gets Second Leaf To His Air Medal

AN EIGHTH AAF BOMBER STATION, England—Sergeant Alfred S. Sevi, of Nazareth, right waist gunner with the Eighth AAF Flying Fortress group commanded by Col. William B. David of Calhoun, Ga., has been awarded his second Oak Leaf Cluster to the Air Medal.

The decoration, equivalent to another award of the medal, was presented for meritorious achievement on bombing attacks in support of Allied forces landing in France.

The flyer is the son of Mrs. Gina Sevi, of Nazareth Route 3, and husband of Mrs. Margaret Sevi of Bangor Route 3. He was a layout man and inspector with the Bethlehem Steel Company in Bethlehem before entering the AAF in December, 1942.
