**Sgt. John Kametler
Gets Second Cluster**

S/Sgt. John J. Kametler, 24-year-old gunner from Bethlehem, has been awarded the second Oak Leaf Cluster to the Air Medal for "meritorious achievement" while participating in Eighth Air Force bombing attacks on vital industries in Ger-

many and on Nazi airfields, in connection with advances by Allied ground forces on the continent.

Sgt. Kametler is a member of the Fortress group which was cited by the President for leading the first American bombing attack on targets in Berlin in March, 1944. The AAF gunner, now stationed in England, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Kametler, this city.
