Private Ernest Duh, husband of Mrs. Julia Duh, and father of a seven months old son, was slightly wounded "somewhere in France," according to a War Department telegram received by his wife. A son of Alex Duh of 207 Eighth Street, Miller Heights, he was inducted into the armed forces on December 21, 1943, received his training at Camp Croft, S. C., and Fort George Meade, Md., he was sent overseas in July of last year, a member of one of the infantry units. He is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Co.
