**Ill in Australia**

Pfc. Joseph F. Sabol, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Sabol, 739 E. Sixth

Street, a member of the Medical Corps of the U. S. Army expeditionary force in the South Pacific, is ill in a Southern Australia hospital, according to a letter from him to his family, received Tuesday.

Sabol, who will celebrate his 30th birthday Friday of this week, was inducted into the service January 18, 1940. He received his early training at Fort Sam Houston, Tex., where he was stationed for 13 months. He was assigned to the Medical Supply Depot upon induction and has remained in that branch since. He left Fort Dix, N. J. on March 1, 1942 and was on the ocean enroute to "parts unknown" when his 29th birthday rolled round.

Prior to induction he was employed as truck driver by Alex Scl oenen. Friends wishing to write to him may obtain his address from his family.
