## Gets Promotion

Grskovich is a graduate of Bethlehem Tech. High School, where he was a star athlete. He enlisted in the service of the United States Navy on November 6, 1942, and received his boot training at the Bainbridge Naval Training Station, Bainbridge, Maryland. He later attended Electricians Mate's School at Newport, R. I., and at present he is on active duty aboard ship in the Pacific theatre. He is the champion wrestler in his class on board ship. On January 8, 1944, he received a commendation from the commander of the ship for "excellent appearance." His present trip to sea is his fourth and recently he spent a two weeks furlough in San Francisco with his wife, the former Mary Priolo, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Luigi Priolo of 1421 East Sixth Street.
