Pfc. Stephen Mish, son of Mr. and Mrs. Martin Mish, 832 Hayes Street, was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received while in action in France.

Inducted February 25, 1942, Pfc. Mish received training at camps in Maryland, Texas, Missouri, and Louisiana before shipping out in March for England, Ireland, Belgium, France and now Holland.

Before his induction, he was employed by the Auto Glass Supply Company. Two brothers are also in the service, Andrew serving in France and Joseph, stationed at Fort Lewis, Washington.
