Lt. Robert Margolis, 20, was recently awarded the Army Air Force Air Medal for meritorious achievement while participating in bomber combat operations over Germany and German-occupied countries.

The young officer is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Margolis, 1825 Jennings Street, Bethlehem, Pa., and received his commission and Navigator's Wings on April 22, 1944. He was assigned to overseas duty and is a member of the 91st Heavy Bombardment Group, Eighth Air Force, located somewhere in England. Lt. Margolis is a navigator on a B-17 Flying Fortress and has been engaged in bomber combat operations since the early part of August, 1944. He is also the holder of a Presidential Citation.
