Pfc. J. Bremmer Dies In Action, Parents Told

Mr. and Mrs. John J. Bremmer, 614 South Bergen Street, were informed in a War Department telegram this morning that their son, Pfc. Joseph J. Bremmer, had been killed in action December 30 in Germany.

He was inducted in March, 1943, and received his training at Camp Polk, Va., before going overseas in May, 1944. He took part in the invasion of France and in the fighting in Belgium, Holland and Germany. He was with the Combat Engineers.

A member of Holy Ghost Church, he attended the Holy Ghost Parochial School. Surviving are his parents and the following brothers and sisters: Cpl. George, somewhere in France; John Jr., at home; Sister M. Bernadette Francis in Philadelphia, and Jeanette, at home.

Memorial services will be held in the Holy Ghost Church at a date to be announced later.
