Killed in Action

Private First Class Joseph Karbo was reported killed in action in Germany January 12 in a War Department telegram received by his wife, the former Mary Banko, Hellertown R. D. 1, January 23. Pfc. Karbo enlisted in the Army in August, 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Croft, S. C.; Camp Wheeler, Ga., and Maryland before going overseas in October, 1944. He has seen action in France, Holland and Belgium. Surviving the young soldier are his wife and a three-year-old daughter, Shirley; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Adam Bohar, 208 Seventh Street, Miller Heights; three sisters and one brother. Pfc. Karbo attended Miller Heights schools and was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before enlisting.
