Lieut. Stark, Nurse, to Marry Indiana Man

Mr. and Mrs. William G. Stark, 1604 Millard Street, announce the engagement of their daughter, First Lieutenant Hildagarde MacGilvray Stark, 24th Evacuation Hospital, United States Armed Forces, Germany, to First Lieutenant William T. Wright, 7th Infantry in France.

Lieutenant Stark, a graduate from Liberty High School in 1937 and from Presbyterian Hospital, Philadelphia, Training School for Nurses in February, 1941, became a Registered Nurse in March, 1941. After graduation she remained at the hospital as Head Nurse of the Urological and Venereal Disease Clinic. She was Assistant Head Nurse in the Urological Department before receiving her commission as Second Lieutenant in the Army Nurse Corps in November, 1942. Lieutenant Stark has been overseas one year. She landed in France in June, 1944, and has since been in Holland and Belgium and is now in Germany with the 24th Evacuation Hospital.

Lieutenant Wright, the son of Mr. and Mrs. William Wright, 125 Alfred Street, Elkhart, Indiana, was graduated from Elkhart High School in 1938 and from Indiana University in 1942. While attending the University he became a member of the Delta Upsilon National Fraternity, and treasurer of the Indiana Chapter of the Fraternity. He was a member of the Indiana Accounting Club and of the Scabard and Blade, a National Honorary Military Fraternity. Upon graduation he received the Bachelor of Science Degree in Business as well as a commission in the Reserved Officers Corps as Second Lieutenant in the Infantry. Being a graduate of Officers Basic Course and Officers Advanced Course at Fort Benning, Georgia, he entered active duty May 26, 1942, and is now with the 7th Infantry in France.
